This letter responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request received on July 23, 2026. You requested the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) provide a copy of the notice of violation or enforcement notice issued by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency in or around September 2025 to Naval Support Activity Crane and/or Crane Army Ammunition Activity (Crane, Indiana) together with the underlying RCRA inspection report and any written response from the Navy or Army, dated between June 1, 2025 and July 23, 2026, the date your request was received.

This is the Enforcement and Compliance Assurance Division's response to your FOIA request. EPA has previously released records responsive to your request on the FOIAxpress system.

You can follow these steps to obtain previously released FOIA records from the public Reading Room:

1. Go to <http://www.epa.gov/foia>
2. Scroll to the end and click on "FOIAxpress public access link's reading room."
3. Click on Reading Room.
4. Scroll to the end and type the FOIA tracking number into the Name box surrounded by asterisks. For example: *2026-EPA-03149*
5. Click on Search. You will then see a download link.

You will receive an invoice if there are any applicable charges for search, reviewing, and duplication of responsive records. If you receive an invoice, please pay within 30 days by mail or online. We encourage you to submit your remittance via the Pay.Gov online option on the invoice to ensure prompt receipt and recording of your payment.

This letter concludes our response to your request. You may appeal this determination in writing within 90 calendar days from the date of this letter by one of the following methods:

- 1) Visit EPA's FOIA submission website (<https://foiapublicaccessportal.epa.gov/>), sign into your account by clicking Sign-In, and select Submit Appeal;

- 2) U.S. Mail sent to the following address: National FOIA Office, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, 1200 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW (2310A), Washington, DC 20460; or
- 3) Overnight delivery service to National FOIA Office, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, 1200 Pennsylvania NW, Room 7309C, Washington, DC 20460.

The Agency will not consider appeals received after the 90-calendar-day limit. Appeals received after 5:00 p.m. EST will be considered received the next business day. The appeal letter should include the FOIA tracking number listed above. For quickest possible handling, the appeal letter, and its envelope, if applicable, should be marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."
